**WHEREAS**, on December 18, 2017, Tier1 Access, LLC (hereinafter, "Tier1") filed a Petition with the Virgin Islands Public Services Commission (hereinafter, "PSC" or the "Commission") for authorization to operate as a telecommunications service provider in the U.S. Virgin Islands; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 25, 2018, the Commission received a report and analysis from its technical consultants, Georgetown Consulting Group, Inc. recommending the approval of Tier1's Petition with certain conditions; and


